

REMOTE CONTROL

The converter DAC100 Signature can be used with the ATOLL remote control that will let you:

- Put ON/OFF the converter.
- Select the sources: with keys SEL \oplus & \ominus , you can select the different inputs.



Putting the converter in Stand-by mode will not change the sound level. This level will be reinitialized at its highest level if the converter is switsh off (11).

USB INPUT

Your appliance is equipped with a High-Res. asynchronous USB Input (B type). It will be possible to use it only when you'll have downloaded the appropriate driver on your computer. This driver can be freely downloaded on our website at the page:

This driver is not required for Macintosh computers.

In order to avoid problems with high quality format transfers (24 bits / 192 kHz or DSD), it is recommended to use a USB connection cable with ferrite
